Helping international students transition to life at Purdue

The International Student Services (ISS) Ambassador Program assists incoming and new international students with their transition to the West Lafayette and at Purdue University to promote a sense of belonging. ISS Ambassadors assist the Programming and Engagement Team with event planning and coordination of events throughout the semester including but not limited to: Week of Welcome, Parent Orientation, Green Flag, and International Education Week. In addition to planning activities, ambassadors will help new students recognize campus challenges of adjusting to a new country such as adjusting to a new culture, getting involved, and finding life in a new academic career.

Qualifications and Responsibilities

The ideal candidate for the ISS Ambassador Program would have the following qualifications:

- Be a current Purdue University graduate or undergraduate student
- Have studied at least one semester at Purdue University
- Be open minded and willing to assist everyone in need of assistance with cultural, social, academic, financial, and personal matters
- Have strong interpersonal communication skills
- Be able to work in a team
